For babies

blankets or shawls.
towelling or muslin nappies
and pins.

disposable nappies,
petroleum jelly, baby soap
and shampoo.

NEW clothes.

Feeding Minds

Education packs

exercise books/note books.
pens and pencils.
colouring pencils or wax
crayons, rulers, erasers,
pencil sharpeners and chalk.

Hand-Knitted items

For Children and babies

Jumpers (ask for our pattern),
cardigans, shawls.
Blankets—6' by 4' or 3' by 4'
(or six inch squares).

Food

donated food needs to be
easy to pack, transport and
store.

In Cans

fish, tomatoes, vegetables,
fruit and can openers.

Dry food

pasta (not canned), rice,
pulses (peas, beans, lentils),
fruit, flour, sugar, salt,
tea / coffee

**We cannot accept meat
or milk products. ALL
food items should have
at least six months'
shelf life.**

For Mothers

soap, shampoo,
flannel, towels
tooth brushes and
tooth paste
sanitary towels, toilet rolls
hair brushes, combs
washing soap and powder

Other Items

blankets, sheets,
sleeping bags, towels,
curtains, candles
underwear (new).
washing up bowls,
buckets (new).
colouring books,
felt pens,
paper, art
materials, school bags,
fabric (any type),
thread, zips, needles.
footballs, tennis balls.
